Landscaping Schedule Lawn Service

The landscaping schedule is as follows: Biweekly Beginning Friday May 9, 2025 To have your backyard mowed, please ensure that the gate to your backyard is open and your yard is clear of all personal belongings upon arrival. If the gate is not opened, then your yard will not be cut. Reminder:

All yards must be as clean as possible: clean up all pet feces, paper, glass, cigarette butts, wood, etc. Remove all toys, lawn furniture, grills, water hoses, trash containers, & any debris or items on the lawn. Any loose pets in your yard will also result in the yard not being mowed. **NOTE: The Association does not allow pools in the backyards.**

Opt Out of Lawn Services:

Homeowners who wish to opt out of the community lawn service must complete the formal opt-out request form in the office and acknowledge their responsibility to maintain their lawn in accordance with community standards.



Yard waste is not picked up at your home.

Please do not throw your debris in the woods or any common areas. You will be fined and charged for cleanup. Yard waste should be placed neatly next to the dumpster area near the Clubhouse/Office. All loose yard waste must be placed in brown paper kraft leaf bags. Please call the Office at 625-7442 with any questions.
