Fall Landscaping


Brightview will resume their services for the Fall season.

We ask that all residents make sure their homes exterior is in compliance with the Community's Guidelines. Any repairs must first be approved by the Board of Trustees prior to starting.

Shrubs, Bushes, Garden Beds

Any shrubs or bushes should not be covering the front windows of your homes.

Residents are responsible for the cutting, trimming, and upkeep of their bushes and garden beds.

Shrubs and bushes should not exceed past 6 feet high.

Brightview Landscaping is NOT responsible for the maintenance of your garden beds, bushes, or shrubbery.
